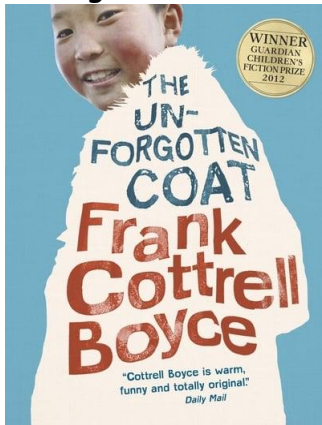


## English

This half term, our writing is based on *The Unforgotten Coat* by Frank Cottrell Boyce which explores refugees and the reasons why people have to flee their countries and seek asylum.

The main outcomes will be to write; extended narratives in the style of a journal, a series of diary entries, an explanation text about a science experiment and a non-chronological report following research on Mongolia.

# Autumn Term Curriculum Overview

## Year 5 & 6 Autumn 2 - 2020

We will ensure that Islamic knowledge is incorporated into the curriculum In Sha Allah.

## Mathematics

We will focus on number skills in particular place value and the four operations. By the end of the half term Year 5 and 6 will be able to:

- multiply and divide whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10, 100 and 1,000 (year 5)
- solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and a combination of these, including understanding the meaning of the equals sign
- solve problems involving multiplication and division, including using their knowledge of factors and multiples, squares and cubes
- Long division method (Year 6)

## PSHE

This term, Year 5 and 6 will be covering the Emotions unit. We will be using role play and many different scenarios to uncover a range of emotions which in sha Allah will help everyone to share.

## Science

We will be investigating earth and space. In this unit, children will be describing the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system, describing the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth, use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky and recording data and results using scientific diagrams and labels, classification keys, tables, scatter graphs, bar and line graphs.

## Homework

Children will be receiving their spellings and homework on Fridays. This year children will receive homework on flip learning so please allow your child access to the internet in order to complete homework in their books. It will focus on the subjects that were covered that week in order to help reinforce their learning. It should be handed in by Thursday each week.
