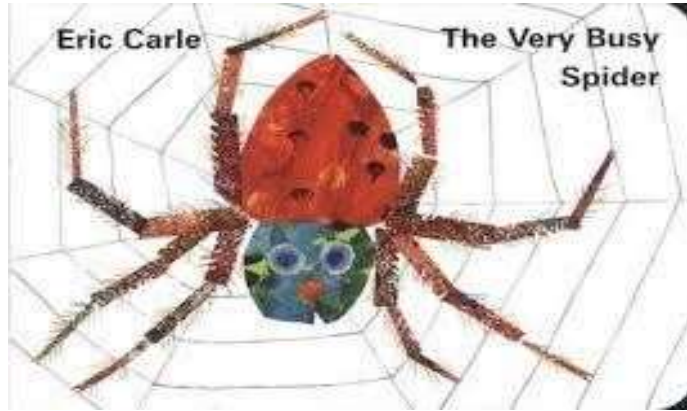

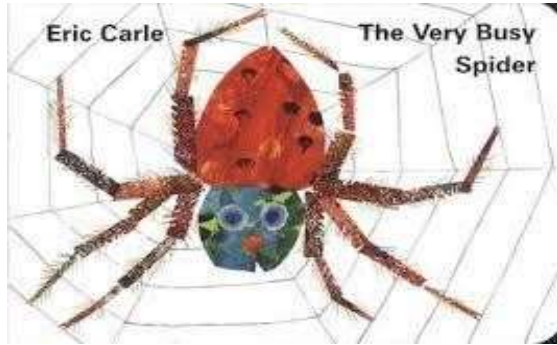

## The Very Busy Spider By Eric Carle:

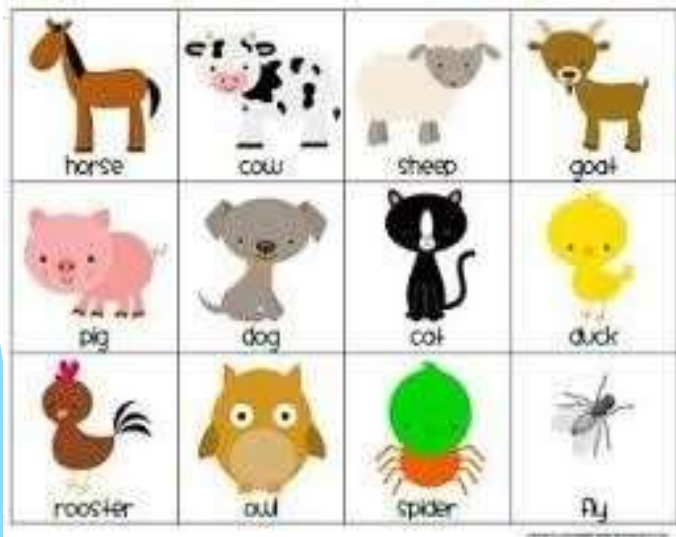
Enjoy listening to the story "The Very Hungry Spider" written by Eric Carle.

Don't forget to send pictures to your teacher via email.

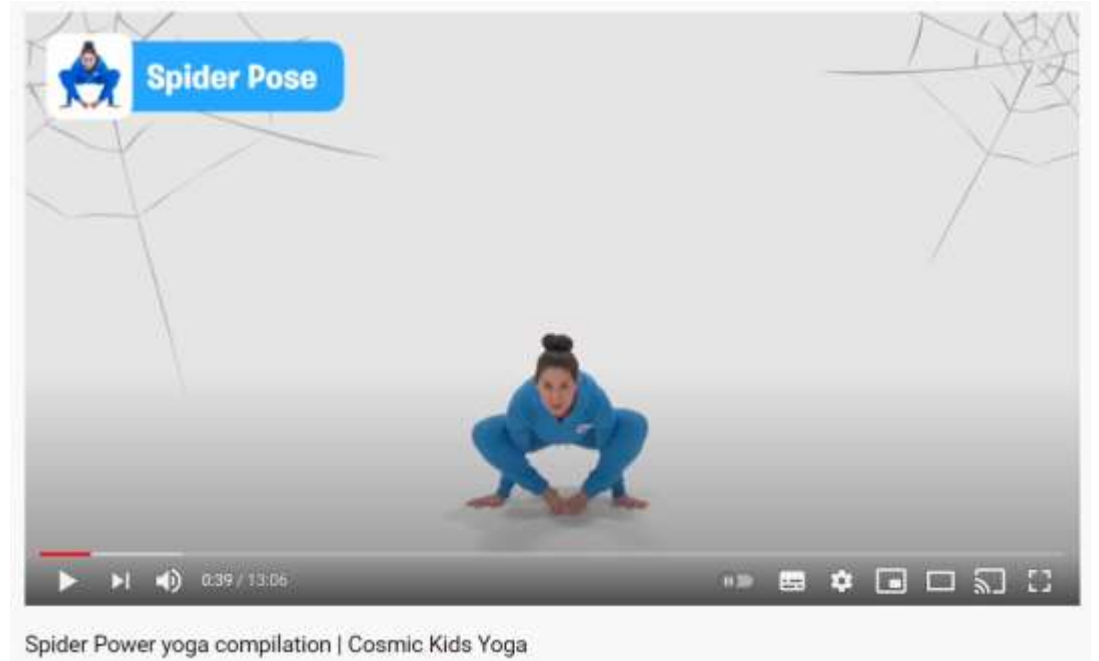
## Make a web
