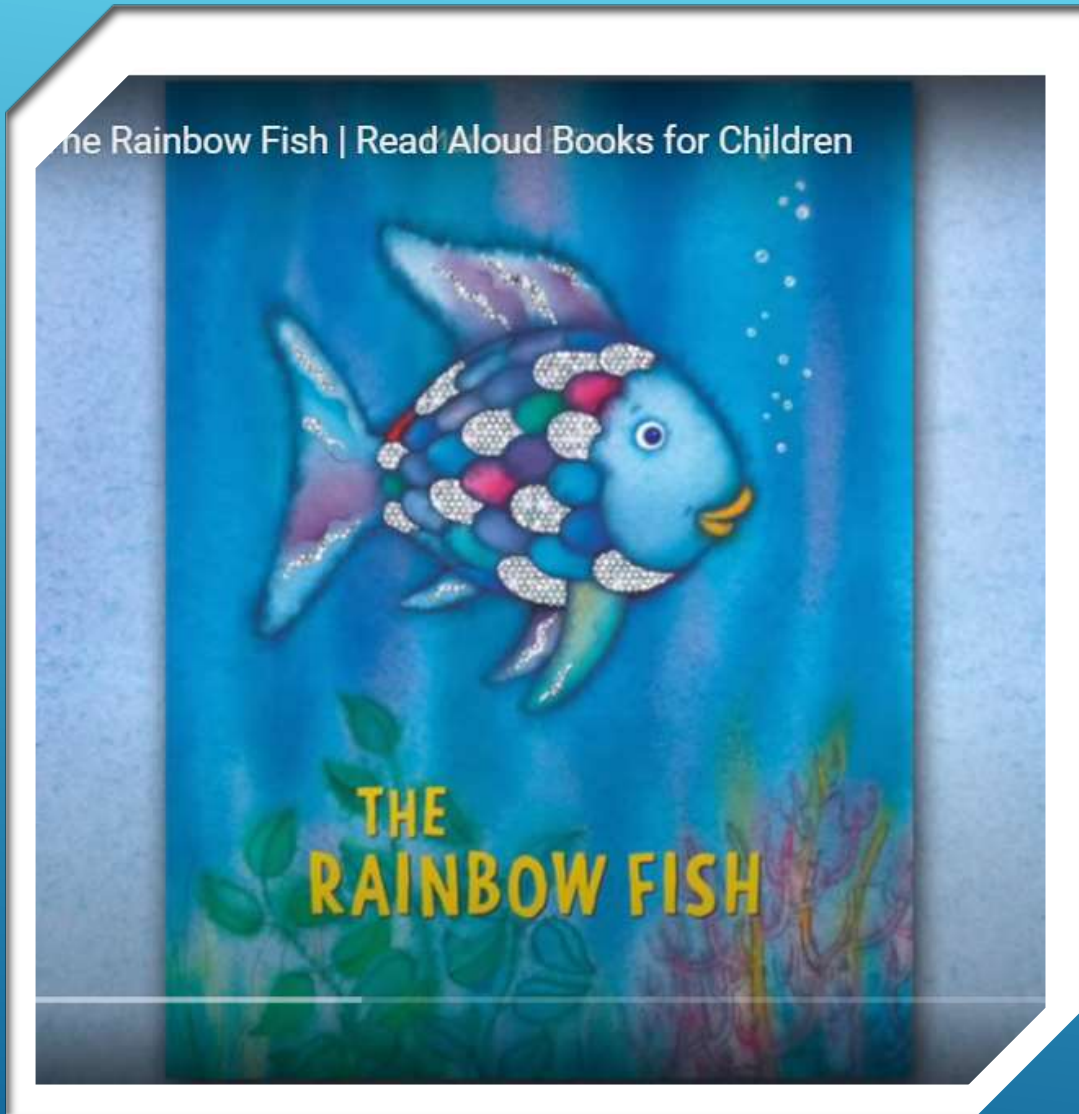

Before we watch the story of the Rainbow Fish let's listen to our Nursery Rhyme.

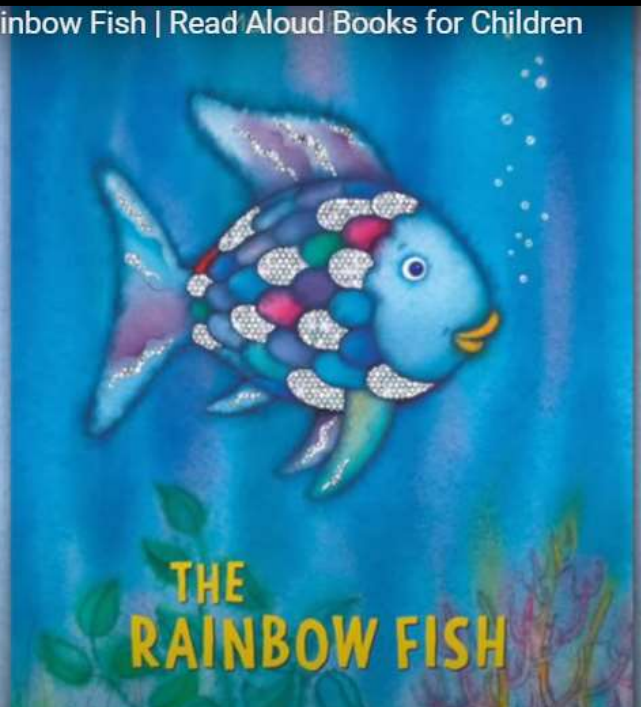

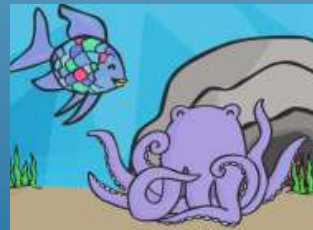

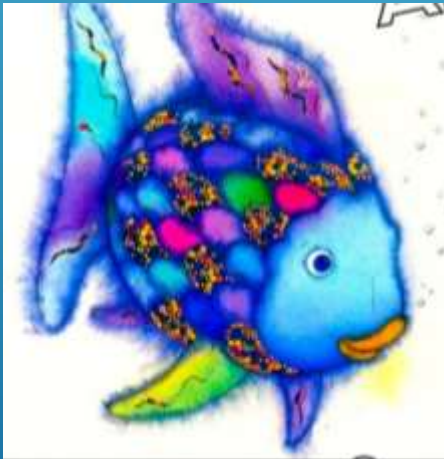
CHALLENGE:

Now we know the story, today we are going to think about the Rainbow fish and what he is like. Think about what he looks like and how he is described in the story but also think about his character and what he is like - how did he treat others? what did he learn? Have a look at the example...now you have a go!

Have a look at the example...

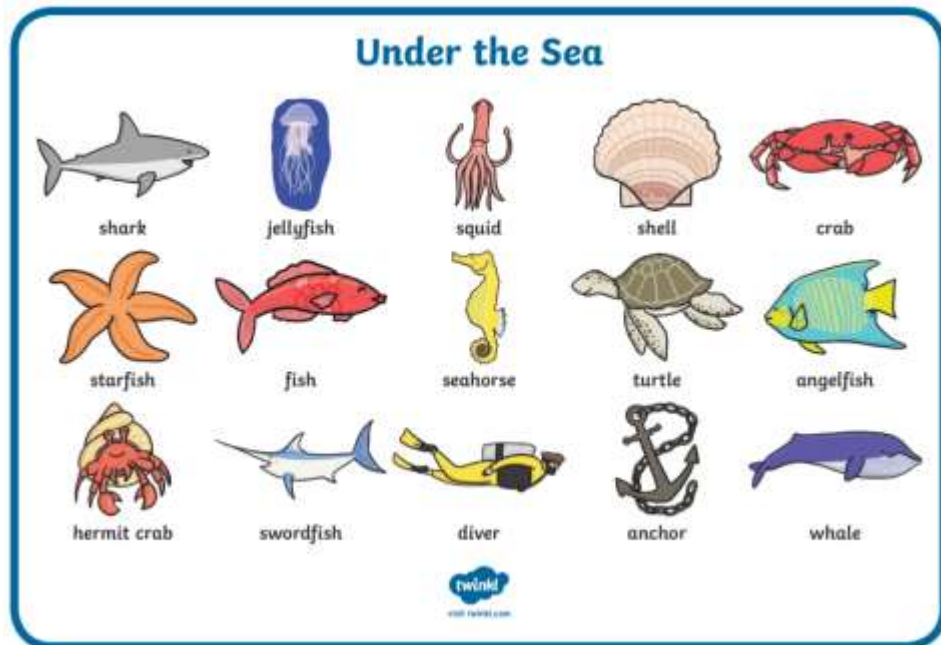


He lives in a big, dark cave.	He is a wise.	He helped the Rainbow fish.

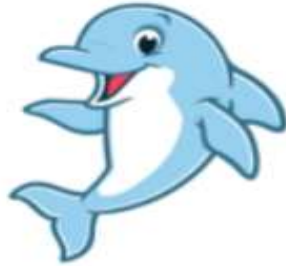
