
Reception Maths Elizabeth Eliza

In maths next week, your child will be learning their 'Number Bonds'. If your child is comfortable with addition and subtraction, then they should be able to understand this with flying colours!!

'Number bonds are often referred to as 'number pairs'. They are simply the pairs of numbers that make up a given number.'

For example, if I said the number 6 to your child, your child should be able to tell me 'two' numbers that add up to 6 and also know that there are not just 1 pair but there are

different pairs to make 6.
