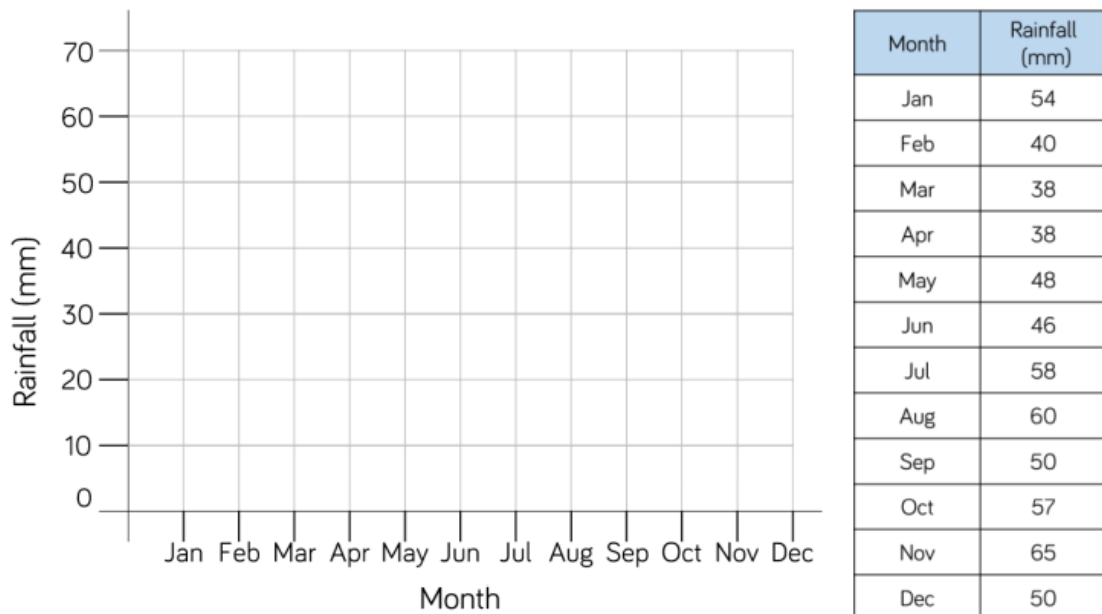

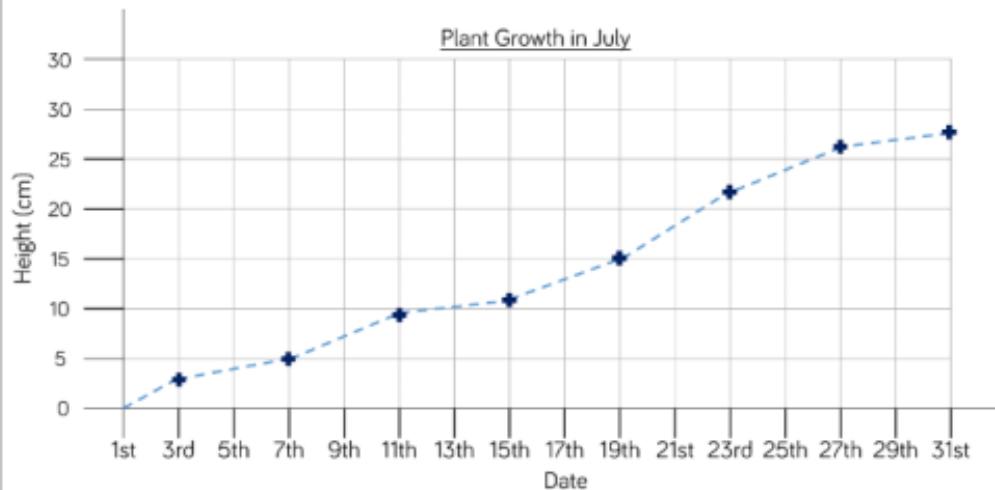
- ❖ The table shows average rainfall in Leicester over a year. Complete the graph using the information from the table.
