

Communication, Language & Literacy

Children will learn:

Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary.

Anticipate - where appropriate - key events in stories.

Use and understand recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, nonfiction, rhymes, and poems and during role-play.

Say a sound for each letter in the alphabet and at least 10 digraphs.

Read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound blending.

Read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.

Write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.

Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters.

Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

Children will learn:

To take part in Obstacle races- linked to sports day

To know how they feel when they are exercising

To develop balancing.

To develop running and stopping

Mathematics

Children will learn:

Counts up to three or four objects by saying one number name for each item.

Counts actions or objects which cannot be moved. •

Counts objects to 10 and beginning to count beyond 10.

Counts out up to six objects from a larger group. •

Selects the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects.

Counts an irregular arrangement of up to ten objects. •

Estimates how many objects they can see and checks by counting them.

Children will learn:

To work as part of a group or class & understand & follow the rules. To adjust their behaviour to different situations, & take changes of routine in their stride

Children will learn:

To experiment with ocean, sea colours to create a piece of artwork of an underwater scene.

To explore wax crayons

To explore materials and its properties and use this to create their own Rainbow fish and ocean.

To use junk modelling to create an underwater habitat for sea creatures.
