English



This half-term, children will be exploring a fantasy text

We will be reading the book Black Dog by Levi Pinfold and identifying the structure of the text.

Children will be looking at the issue of the size of the dog and how it relates to fear and worry. Children will write their own suspenseful story, based on a fear they might have using similar structure of Black Dog.

Opportunities to embed speech, and adverbials for how, where and when, which they will apply within their own writing.

Mathematics

Islamic Links

Science

In science we will be learning about *Light and Shadow*.

We will be able to understand that:

We need **light** to be able to see things. **Light** travels in a straight line. When **light** hits an object, it is **reflected** (bounces off). If the **reflected light** hits our eyes, we can see the object. Somesurfaces and materials **reflect light** well. Other materials do not **reflect light** well. **Reflective** surfaces and materials can bevery useful....
