RAMADAN DECORATION IDEAS

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Your homework for this holiday, is to design and or create posters about Ramadan. Here are some ideas or you choose to do your own.

1. Decorate your own qibla arrow or prayer mat with traditional colour and designs

2. **Ramadan around the world**

Have a look at images on the computer, then you can talk about what do we all do the same, what do we do differently. It can be interesting to see the different foods for iftar, and different customs. Use the information and make a collage.

3. **Making Lanterns** – Making lanterns is a traditional Ramadan craft. Make mini lanterns, or paper lanterns with a hole punch – the options are endless.

4. **Moon Crafts and Activities**

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The Islamic calendar is measured by the moon, but how much do you know about the moon?

Learn about the way the moon is sighted for the beginning of Ramadan, and for Eid, and about the 3 “white days” (ayyam al beed) when the full moon shows and its recommended to fast them during any month. Write an information leaflet for younger children to learn all about it.
