

English

This term KS1 will be looking at the book 'If all the world were'. The book looks at the relationship between a grandparent and grandchild over different seasons. It then looks at how the child deals with the loss of their grandparent.

KS1 will be writing letters and doing diary entries to explore their feelings about this book. They will also build on the vocabulary that they have previously learnt.

Later in the term KS1 will move onto looking at poetry.

Islamic link: Children will learn how we can earn Jannah points to go to Jannah. They will learn how we all go back to Allah. What duas we say when someone dies.

DT

Teddy Bear's Picnic- KS1 will learn about different types of picnic food and where they come from. They will be given the opportunity to explore and taste different picnic food. By the end of the term, they will learn how to design a food skewer to take on a picnic were grandparents will be invited too to join the KS1 team. They will learn about the importance of a balanced diet and what is needed to stay healthy.

Cross Curricula Links- Learn about shapes and sequencing and see what sort of fruits are popular around the world using tally charts.
Islamic Link - learn about different cultures and traditional food people eat around the world.

Autumn 1 Curriculum Overview 2022

KS1 - YEAR 1-2

Islamic knowledge is incorporated into the curriculum

Maths

Year 1 - This term year 1 will begin their learning with place value within 10. They will learn place value through sorting objects to understanding what less than, greater than and equal to means. This helps them identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representation including the number line and use mathematical language. Children will also learn how the same collection of objects can be sorted in different ways.

Year 2 - This term year 2 will recap on their learning about place value on number to 20. Children will revisit these number explicitly before moving on to look at numbers to 100.

PE

In this term, KS1 will focus on Skills based activities, using teamwork as the central focus. Children will also gain skills in throwing (under arm, over arm, bounce) catching and rolling and so forth. This will allow children to form relationships and find buddies.

Science

Growing Plants

This term KS1 will be understanding how different seeds grow into different plants and be asked to describe them. They will understand how plants can be grown from bulbs and then told to carry out and evaluate an investigation into the conditions that affect germination. KS1 children will refer to prior learning and consider how plants change over time.

Islamic Learning - Children will understand how planting trees is a act of charity and how plants can provide a cure for different illnesses. Children will also learn how plants are important to many people around the world and provide a living in different countries and different plants grow in different seasons.

History

KS1 will be looking at 'childhood, then and now'. Children will be looking at how clothes, toys, homes and schools were in the past and comparing them to now.

Islamic link: How we should be thankful for what we have when some children don't have anything. To always be grateful to Allah.

P.S.H.E

This term, KS1 will learn about 'feelings'. They will learn about different emotions and how they might feel in different situations. They will be made aware of who they can speak to if they are facing difficulties. Children will be made aware that it is ok to feel different emotions and how they can learn to control them. KS1 will do role play situations to help build their understand on this area.

Islamic link: How we can control how emotions through duas and connecting with Allah.
