Key Notes:

- Maths, Reading and SPAG results are based on a the 2022 SATS tests, that were marked internally.
- Being the first year after the impact of Covid-19, year 6 have made significant progress from their Covid baseline results. Maths had the most significant increase with 69% higher results, followed by Reading at 55% and then by Writing at 50%
- Children perform well in lessons achieving Greater Depth or Expected in most lessons
- Year 6 had consistent weekly recovery lessons for Maths and English
- Writing was based on an independent piece of work, using the Ross Wilson marking criteria for
 Y6
- SPAG and Reading are the strongest subject in Year 6 with all children achieving 100% in SPAG and 88% achieving the Age Related Expected Standard in Reading.
