6. A dog barked.


Earth Day 2023: Invest in Our Planet



Earth Day is on 22nd April every year. Earth Day 2023 is called 'Invest in Our Planet'. This means that everyone should work together to help look after the Earth.


Why Do We Need to Help Our Planet?


