

For maths this week your child has been learning how to represent 1 2 and 3 in different ways.

Ask your child to look around the home and find objects to represent these numbers, for example 1 apple, 2 spoons and 3 toy cars.

In their maths books your child draw what they found and write the number what the objects represent.

Also encourage your child to form their numbers correctly using the number rhymes

	<b>one</b>	Straight line down and then you're done! 1 is fun.
	<b>two</b>	Half a heart will never do, Slide to the right, make a 2.
	<b>three</b>	Around the tree, around the tree, That's the way to make a 3.
