A man called Samuel Pepys started to write about what was happening in his diary.



St Paul's Cathedral was destroyed in the fire.



Buildings were pulled down and water was thrown using leather buckets and water squirts. This did not stop the fire and so it continued to spread.



A fire for baking had not been put out. The fire soon spread towards other buildings.



The fire started on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1666 in a baker's shop on Pudding Lane.



The fire spread easily because many of the buildings were close together and made out of wood.



Because the wind had died down and many houses were pulled down to stop the fire spreading, the fire stopped.



The fire started to burn more slowly as the wind died down.



The fire spread very close to the Tower of London.
